Goals and Objectives

Communication Skills

The student will:

- Identify Common objects
- Identify parts of the body
- Understand negatives such as “no” and “can’t”
- Count by rote 1 - 10
- Say alphabet by rote
- Participate in simple group activities, games, songs
- Listen to a simple story
- Find a name at a table
- Identify basic colors

Cognitive Skills

The student will:

- Respond to simple directions
- Select and look at simple picture books
- Group associated objects such as cup and saucer
- Beginning to understand whole-part concepts
- Stack rings in order from large to small
- Recognize self in mirror

Pre-Writing Skills

The student will:

- Hold crayon with thumb and fingers, not fist
- Paint with some wrist action, make dots, lines, and circular strokes
- Imitate circular, vertical, horizontal strokes

- Use one hand consistently

Personal-Social Skills

The student will:

- Get a drink from the fountain independently
- Take off coat by themselves
- Wash and dry hands with assistance
- Use objects symbolically
- Listen to directions
- Play next to other children
